Company First to Market with \$2,000 Per Month Flat-Rate Service

MCLEAN, Va., February 2, 2006 – First Avenue Networks (NASDAQ: FRNS), a fixed wireless services provider, today announced Government Connection, its flat-rate plan for Carrier Ethernet and existing transport services. The plan is structured to provide Carrier Ethernet services up to 100 Mbps as well as NxDS-1, DS-3 or OC-3 connections to government agencies and suppliers for \$2,000 per month.

To meet increasing data requirements and federal compliance standards for physically diverse and redundant networks, government agencies need the flexibility and capacity of services such as Carrier Ethernet to future proof their networks. Estimates are that 85 percent of the buildings in a given metro area do not have fiber access, precluding the delivery of Carrier Ethernet and other high capacity services.

Offering government-grade connectivity over licensed spectrum at high availability (99.995%), Government Connection provides agencies and their suppliers with a simple plan for deploying primary and redundant high capacity transport connections.

“The government’s requirement for broadband communications is driven by the need for high availability and for the diverse routing of critical information,” said retired Lt. Gen. John B. Conaway, chairman & CEO of the Conaway Group, and former Chief of the National Guard Bureau. “Today, agencies are struggling to provide secure and protected communication services while controlling their costs. The market is ripe for a cost-effective fixed wireless offering with government-grade services that enables an agency to meet these needs.”
